

JOB TITLE: ELECTRIC SEASONAL GROUNDMAN (Hourly: Non-exempt)

ACCOUNTABILITY: Under supervision, to assist linemen in the construction and maintenance of an electric distribution and transmission system as a part of a formal training program; and to do related work as required.

DUTIES - EXAMPLES OF WORK: Performs increasingly difficult line maintenance and construction work on non-energized lines s proficiency in creases; during beginning period of training, all work will be on the ground; performs elementary line maintenance and repair work on non-energized lines by placing transformers, insulators, crossarms; thereafter, line work progresses to working on low energy lines or less complex work on higher voltage lines; assists in installing service drops; may trim trees to protect electrical equipment; may operate boom and winch; assist in loading and unloading of poles.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ability to perform heavy manual work; mechanical ability; ability to read and understand blueprints or working diagrams; ability to learn skilled mechanical tasks; ability to work at heights; ability to work harmoniously with others; ability to drive a light truck.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING: Any combination of training and experience equivalent to graduation from high school, including courses or knowledge in shop mechanics and electricity.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of valid driver's license.
