JOB TITLE: WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR AIDE (SEASONAL) (Hourly: Non-exempt)

ACCOUNTABILITY: Under the direction of the Seward Recreation Department and Swim Program Coordinator.

JOB SUMMARY: Introducing swimming and water safety skills to the lower levels of students and assists Water Safety Instructors with the upper levels; assist with emergencies.
